

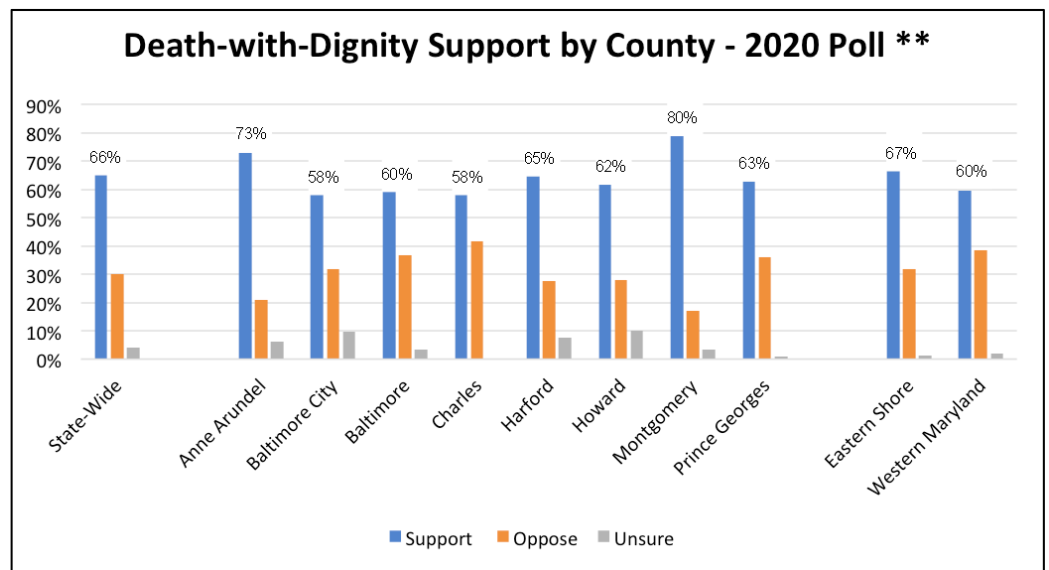
Death with Dignity Polling Update: 2019-2020
